Indicator	Source	Description
Under 18 hospital admissions	NWPHO	Persons admitted to hospital due to alcohol specific conditions (under 18s), crude rate per 100,000 population
Alcohol related Emergency Department attendances	NWPHO	% of individuals who consumed alcohol in the 3 hours prior to the incident requiring ED attendance
Drinking Frequency	Training Standards	% of 14-17 year olds drinking once or more a week
Binge Drinking	Training Standards	% of 14-17 year olds drinking 5 or more on one occasion more than once a week
Under aged access	Training Standards	% of 14-17 year olds claiming to buy alcohol for themselves
Regretted sex	Training Standards	% of 14-17 year olds who report ever regretting having sex with someone after drinking.
Violence when drunk	Training Standards	% of 14-17 year olds reporting having been violent or in a fight whilst drunk
In a car with someone drunk	Training Standards	% of 14-17 year olds reporting having been in a car with a young person driving who had been drinking alcohol.
NEET	DfE	% of 16 and 17 year olds not in employment, education or training (NEET)
Under 18 conceptions	DfE	Reduction in the number of conceptions per 1000 women aged 15-17 years based on a 1998 baseline
Chlamydia prevalence	DH	Episodes of Chlamydia diagnosed for young people aged 15 -19 as a % of all 15 to 19 years olds.
School exclusions	DfE	The number of permanent exclusions from secondary schools in the academic year expressed as a percentage of the school population.
